

OBITUARY. Aunt Sarah Nelson, whose sickness has been mentioned from time to time, breathed her last at her home north of this place October 19, 1904. She was born April 26, 1828, on the very spot where she died. She was married to George Wayman in March, 1848. To this union were born two sons, Jas. W. and C. L. Wayman. Mr. Wayman died in 1852. On October 25, 1868, she was united in marringe to Joel F. Nelson, who with the two sons and a host of friends are left to mourn their loss She was a daughter of Judge Andy Robertson and a sister of Hon. Geo. A. Robertson and Esq. Long Bill Robertson of this place. Aunt Sally, as she was familiarly known, was a model woman and a true type of American womanhood. In early life she united with the Church of Christ and in that faith she lived a consistent member for more than three score years. No one ever applied to her for food or shelter that was turned away. She has gone to accept that crown of rightiousness prepared for her from the foundation of the world. The funeral services was conducted at the family residence by Elder G. M. Shutts, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.
