Perrin—Andy Perrin died at his home in Brownstown Thursday, May 11, 1922, after a long illness, aged 76 years, 1 month and 24 days. About fifteen months ago he suffered a stroke of paralysis and suffered a second stroke two weeks ago.

Deceased was born near Henryville, Clark county, Indiana, March 17, 1846. His parents died when he was quite young and he made his home with an older brother until the outbreak of the Civil war when he enlisted in Company F, 50th Indiana Infantry, which was consolidated with the 52nd, and was discharged at Montgomery, Ala., June 4, 1865.

He was united in marriage to Susan Jane Hartsock at Pleasant Hill, Ill., April 17, 1870. To this union were born four children, of whom three survive him, Wm. T. Perrin of Brownstown; Mrs. D. W. Shull, of Indianapolis, and Mrs. Eugene Hayes, of Jackson, Miss. On March 1, 1893, he was married to Miss Rose Eita Goss, of Brownstown, who survives him. He also leaves fourteen grandchildren, six great-grandchildren and one brother, W. J. Perrin, of Brownstown.

Funeral services were conducted at his late home Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. C. H. Earenfight, pastor of the Christian church, officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
