PERRIN—Mrs. Mary Myers Perrin, wife of Wm. T. Perrin, formerly of this place, died at Chicago, Saturday, April 8, 1916, of gall stones and heart trouble, after a lingering illness of about twenty weeks in the hospital. The remains were brought here Monday and taken to the home of her father-in-law, Wm. Perrin, where funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock, followed by interment in Fairview cemetery.

Deceased was born near Knoxville, Tenn., January 17, 1876, and moved with her parents to Brownstown about twenty-five years ago. She was united in marriage to Wm. T. Perrin of this place, March 13, 1895. They moved to Chicago about 1899, where they have resided most of the time since. To their union were born five children—one boy, who died in infancy—and four girls, Verna, Irene, Ruth and May, who with the father survive her. She also leaves her mother and three brothers, of San Francisco; three brothers in St. Louis; one brother in Knoxville, Tenn.; one sister in Iuka, Ill., and one sister in Missouri.
