### Pfaffenberger.

Mrs. Florence Pfaffenberger died at her residence on Walnut Street on Monday, July 25th, 1898, after a lingering illness of six months. Last winter she had an attack of catarrhal fever, which developed into pulmonary troubles that defied the skill of the best physicians.

Mrs. Pfaffenberger was a daughter of Oregan and Susannah Wray and was born near Clear Spring Feb. 23rd, 1868. On the 3rd of August, 1889, she was married to Wright Pfaffenberger and two children were born to this union, Flora and Guy (aged 8 and 5, respectively) who with her parents, one sister, Mrs. Flora Dodds, and two brothers James and Roy Wray remain to mourn her loss.

On the 18th of April last she united with the M. E. Church of this place, a mention of which was made in the BANNER at the time.

The funeral services, conducted by Rev. E. L. Sanders, were held at the residence on Wednesday at 2 P. M., after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
