MRS. LYDIA A. PHIFER, wife of Jas. H. Phifer, died at her home at this place, Thursday, March 20, 1902, after a lingering illness of consumption, aged 46 years, 2 months and 6 days. The funeral services were held at the residence Saturday morning at 10 o'clock, Rev. C. C. Bonnell officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Deceased was born in Brownstown, Ind., January 14, 1856, and was the youngest child of Aaron and Eliza Stryker. She was united in marriage to James H. Phifer, January 21, 1885, when they went to St. Louis and made that place their home until 1896, when they returned to Brownstown and have since resided here.

She united with the M. E. Church when quite young and remained a faithful member and worker until she moved away, but came in again by certificate, Feb 3, 1902. One of her first thoughts was always for the comfort and pleasure of the one she had promised to love, cherish and obey.

The deceased has been an invalid for several years, but she bore her suffering with Christian fortitude with very little murmuring and complaining.
