C. Reinbold Dies Thursday, Rites Are Set

Charles "Cocky" Reinbold, 67, of Brownstown, died at 8:51 p. m. Thursday at the Marion Veterans Hospital in Marion. He had been ill since 1969.

A veteran of World War II, Mr. Reinbold was a retired bartender. He was born January 20, 1908, in Brownstown to the late John and Nora Cordell Reinbold and had lived most his life in Jackson County.

Survivors include one son, Charles Farrell Reinbold, of Seymour; three brothers, Clifford Reinbold, of Seymour, and Albert and Raymond Reinbold, of Brownstown; two sisters, Mrs. Marguerite Albertson and Mrs. Bernice Knuckles, of Brownstown; and one grandson. Two sisters preceded him in death.
