PROMINENT COUNTY RESIDENT PASSES

John A. Reinbold, 58, Citizen of Jackson County All His Life, Dies Today.

HAD BEEN ILL LONG TIME

John Andrew Reinbold, age 58, a resident of Jackson county all of his life, died suddenly about 10 o'clock Wednesday morning at his home in Brownstown following a long illness of asthma and heart trouble. The decedent had been critically ill for the past ten days or more, and had been ailing for four years or more.

Mr. Reinbold was born in Driftwood township, Jackson county and was a successful farmer for years.

Besides his widow, Nora (Cordell) Reinbold, he is survived by seven children, Clifford Reinbold, of Seymour; Charles, Aloert and Raymond Reinbold, at home and Mrs. Margarete Alberson, of Indianapolis; Mrs. Geneva Doobin, of Kalamazoo, Mich., and Bernice Reinbold, at home. Two brothers, Charles Reinbold, well known Brownstown grocerman and L. F. Reinbold, also of Brownstown, and one sister, Mrs. Orpha Jones, of Indianapolis, also survive.

The deceased was a member of the Methodist church, and was also affiliated with the Red Men's lodge.

Funeral arrangements have not been completed but the rites will probably be held some time Thursday or Friday.
