Berry Richards, son of J. B. and S. A. Richards, deceased, whose illness we have mentioned in these columns, died at his home August 27, 1910, after a lingering illness of consumption. About eleven months ago he went to Colorado for the benefit of his health but to no avail and all that loving hands could do was done. He was born at this place November 23, 1856, and at the time of his death he was 54 years, 9 months and 4 days old. He was united in marriage to Narrah C. Browning March 5, 1895, and to their union was born one son—Clarence, together with his wife, two sisters and five brothers survive him, viz: William, of Brownstown; R. L., of Sikeston, Mo.; Meade, of Staunton, Ill.; Mrs. Lean Robertson, of Honeytown, and Mrs. Ed Powell and Thomas P. of this place. He was well known and had a host of friends.
