Robbins—Mrs. Jane Robbins, widow of the late Benjamin Robbins, passed away at her home in Brownstown Saturday night, July 2, of general infirmities, aged 81 years, 6 months and 11 days.

Deceased was the daughter of John and Margaret Gorden and was born in Washington county, December 22, 1840. She was the fourth child of a family of nine children, all of whom have preceded her to the grave with the exception of one sister, Martha E. Morris, of Indianapolis. She was united in marriage to Alfred Morris September 25, 1879, who died in 1863. In June, 1899, she was married to Benjamin Robbins, who preceded her in death six years ago. In early life she united with the Methodist church at New Philadelphia, Washington county, and remained a member thereof until death.

Funeral services were conducted at her late home Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. F. M. Moore, pastor of the Presbyterian church, officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
