**Body Will Be Taken To Brownstown  
Sunday for Burial—Former  
Resident of Seymour.**

Mrs. Catherine Rodman, aged eighty-six years, widow of the late Dr. William Martin Rodman, died Thursday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George Klauss, in Belzoni, Miss., according to word received here this morning. Dr. Rodman lived in Brownstown and Seymour where he practiced his profession. He died some years ago and Mrs. Rodman lived with her daughter in Mississippi.

Mrs. Rodman was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Asher Woodmansee and was born in Brownstown. She was twice married, her first husband being the late Thomas Cowling.

The body will be shipped to Brownstown and the funeral will be held there Sunday, according to the dispatch. The body will be buried beside the grave of her husband at Fairview cemetery in Brownstown.
