

Death of Mrs. Rachel Rodman.

As announced last week, Mrs. Rachel Rodman died suddenly from heart trouble, Wednesday, May 24, 1893. She had been feeling unusually well for some time and no fears were entertained of any immediat: trouble. She was not known to have been troubled with heart disease, though her sons and daughters have feared that such a fate might overtake her. Their fears are realized. Mrs. Rodman had been about the place attending to many duties, and was just returned from the garden where she had been for an hour past. Sitting on the porch she asked her daughter, Mary to bring her a glass of water from the pump about forty feet away. Before she returned her mother was dead. The children were notified of the death and the burial was withheld until the arrival of her youngest son, Dick, who was in Arizona, he being the only one who could attend. He arrived Sunday and the funeral was conducted from the Christian Church, Monday, Rev. G. M. Shutts officiating.
