SANDERS — Miss Mollie Sanders whose illness has been mentioned in these columns, died Friday night, April 20, 1906, aged 27 years, 1 month and 3 days. She was brought home from Columbus several months ago with symptoms of typhoid fever and continued to grow worse until her death. Several years ago Miss Mollie learned the printer's trade in the Telephone office at Brownstown and for a few years past had been working at her trade in the Republican office at Columbus and also assisted some in the office of her uncle, Dr. Holder, of that city, who assisted in giving her every possible care and attention during her last illness.

She was a young lady of pleasant disposition and pleasing manners and had a host of friends. She was converted in early life and was later baptized into the fellowship of the Baptist church and lived a consistent member thereof. The funeral services were conducted by her pastor, Rev. L. B. Arvin, at the Baptist church Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

She is survived by her mother, four sisters—Misses Carrie, Obie, Mattie and Mrs. Gilbert Ball—and one brother, Frank, who was at Bainbridge, Ga., at the time of her death, but arrived here in time for the funeral.
