Schwein—Mrs. Louisa Catherine Schwein, age 87 years, died at her home in Brownstown Friday at 12:00 noon. Death was due to a fractured hip she suffered in a fall at her home on Monday.

Funeral services were conducted at the Presbyterian church Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Walter M. Zeanah. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mrs. Schwein was a life-long resident of Jackson county. She was the daughter of Henry and Louise Herrmann Gossman, natives of Germany. She was born on the Gossman homestead a mile east of Brownstown July 20, 1855, and spent her girlhood days there. She was the last surviving member of a family of eight children. On December 15, 1881, she was married to William Schwein, who died March 22, 1924.

Mrs. Schwein had been a member of the Presbyterian church since 1875 and was one of the most faithful attendants as long as her health permitted. She was a good mother, neighbor and leaves many friends to mourn her death.
