WILLIAM SCHWEIN, SR. DIES AT BROWNSTOWN

**Pioneer Resident Born in County
Stricken Friday—Is Survived
By Widow And Children.**

William Schwein, Sr., a pioneer resident of Brownstown, died at his home this morning at 6:15 o'clock from a stroke of paralysis suffered Friday afternoon about 5 o'clock. He was milking a cow at the barn when stricken and was carried into the house where he sank into unconsciousness which resulted in death. He had suffered a slight stroke previously and had not been in good health since.

Mr. Schwein was born in Brownstown township and resided in or near Brownstown all of his life. He would have been 75 years of age on next April 2. He engaged in truck gardening and sale of garden seeds in his later active life and was one of the well known older residents of that city. He was a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian church and the Knights of Pythias lodge.

Surviving are the widow, two sons, William, Jr., and Henry, of Brownstown, two daughters, Mrs. Emil Heller, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Minnie Reed, of Indianapolis.

Burial will be in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown, the funeral in charge of Rev. F. M. Moore, at the Brownstown Presbyterian church, on Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock.
