

SCOTT-Henry Scott, brother of Mrs. Joel H. Matlock died Wednesday Jan. 13, at 8 a. m. at his home at Indianapolis after an illness of h arttrouble and a complication of diseases. Age about 60 years. He had been in poor health for some time and death was not unexpected, Mr., Spott was formerly progrietor of the Aetna House at Brownstown. After moving to Indianapolis five or six years ago he was engaged in the hotel business there Most of his life was spent in Jackson county. He leaves a widow and seven, children, three sons and four daughters, among whom is Mrs. C. A. Bolles, of Brownstown. Mrs. Matlock, is the only living sister. Mrs. John Morton, of this city, and Shannon Gray, of Brownstown, are half sister and half brother of the deceased. He was a member of the Masons and the Knights of Pythias The remains will be taken to Brownstown for burial.

The deceased was formerly coroner of Jackson county and was quite well known and had a host of friends.
