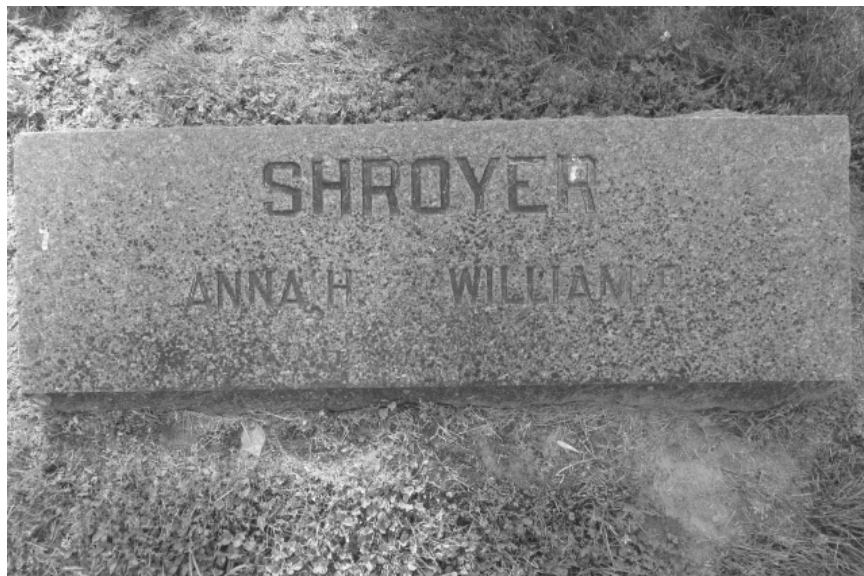

Wm. C. Shroyer Expires At 78

Was Justice Of The Peace In
Brownstown And Also Served
Term As Marshal.

William C. Shroyer, age 78, passed away at his home in Brownstown Monday morning at 9:20 o'clock. Death was due to asthma with complications. He had been ill since the middle of December but had been confined to his bed only a few days.

Mr. Shroyer was born near Albany, Delaware county, Indiana, February 5, 1858, the son of Samuel Jones and Elizabeth Boyles Shroyer. He taught school for sixteen years before coming to Brownstown. He served as town marshal of Brownstown and was Justice of Peace at the time of his death and was well known over the county. He was a member of the Masonic lodge and the Methodist church.

Deceased was married twice. His first marriage was to Ollie Currant in 1880. To that union was born one daughter, Mabel Shroyer Carter, who preceded him in death. Two sisters have also preceded him in death in the past two years. On November 26, 1903, he was married to Miss Anna Hackendorf at the bride's home in Brownstown.

Besides his widow he leaves five sisters, Mrs. Majilda Barnes, Mrs. Lola Maitland, Mrs. Clara Boots, all of Albany; Mrs. Ora Wingate, of Selma, Ind., Mrs. Cora Justice of Muncie; two grandchildren, Mrs. Yrea Richey, of Albany, and William Carter, of Anderson, and a large number of other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were conducted at the Methodist church this afternoon at 1:30 o'clock in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Thos. J. Hart. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
