Brownstown Woman Dead

Mrs. Ada M. Stewart Stuckwisch, age fifty-seven, of Brownstown, well known Jackson county resident, died Friday morning at 8:15 o'clock at the home of her son, Forrest Stewart, of Brownstown. Death followed a week's illness and was due to a stroke.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the home of her son and at 2 o'clock from the Brownstown Lutheran Church with the Rev. Th. Herrmann, pastor, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Stuckwisch was born on March 12, 1881, at Brownstown, the daughter of William H. and Sarah C. Jones. She spent most of her life in that vicinity and made many friends who mourn her death.
