Wilbur A. Stewart, 57, 1315 West Commerce street, Brownstown, was dead on arrival at Schneck Memorial Hospital at 10:30 p. m. Wednesday.

He had been ill since 1965.

A lifelong resident of Brownstown, he had owned and operated Stewart's Electric store there since 1929. He was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Seymour Lodge No. 462, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and the Refrigeration Service and Engineers Society.

Born Dec. 26, 1910, in Brownstown, he was the son of the late Arthur Wesley and Ada M. Jones Stewart.

On Aug. 27, 1939, in Seymour, he married the former Leona Siefker, who survives.
