### Rites Monday for J. Willard Stout, Democrat, Former County Official

Funeral services for J. Willard Stout, 80, a native and well known former resident of Jackson county, have been set for 10 o'clock Monday morning from the Flanner and Buchanan Fall Creek Mortuary, Indianapolis. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Friends may call at the mortuary after noon today.

Mr. Stout, an active Democrat who was widely known in politics and had many friends in both major parties, died Wednesday at his home, 1510 North Alabama street, Indianapolis.

While a resident of Jackson

county, he served two terms as county clerk and two terms as deputy auditor. He was born at Reddington, the son of the late John and Mary Shanton Stout. His father was a Civil War veteran and livery stable operator. He was graduated from grade and high school at Seymour and then moved to Brownstown, where he lived for 20 years.

Mr. Stout went to Indianapolis 35 years ago and was proud of the fact that for 30 years he was precinct committeeman in the Third Precinct, Eighth Ward, there. For 19 years he was employed in the engineer's office at City Hall, Indianapolis, retiring 18 months ago because of impaired eyesight.

A graduate of the LaSalle School of Accounting in Chicago, Mr. Stout was a public accountant and was keenly interested in projects for civic improvement. He was a member of the Reddington Church, Washington Masonic Lodge at Brownstown, Knights of Pythias and Independent Order of Odd Fellows. He also was a member of the Democratic Club of Indianapolis.

He is survived by the widow, Mrs. May Stout, Indianapolis, and a daughter, Mrs. Thomas Caulkins, Bombay, India, whose husband is associated with Standard Oil Company there.
