Mrs. Sarah A. Huber, aged eighty-two years, mother of George L. Tovey, local shoe merchant, died Monday morning at the home of her son C. P. Tovey, North Ewing street in Seymour, following a long illness with paralysis. Her condition had been critical for several days and Mr. Tovey with other children had been at her bedside.

Mrs. Huber was born in Delaware May 20, 1839, and on April 5, 1857, she was married to the late George R. Tovey. After his death she was married on July 7, 1889 to Mr. Huber who died several years ago. She is survived by three sons, William J. Tovey, of Mexico; C. P. Tovey, of Seymour, G. L. Tovey, of this city and two daughters, Mrs. Anna Phegley, of Surprise, and Mrs. Susan G. Kent, of Brownstown. She also leaves twenty grandchildren and twenty-five great-grand children.

The funeral will be held from the Tovey residence in Seymour at 9:30 o'clock Wednesday morning by the Rev. L. E. Murray, pastor of the Central Christian church. Burial at Brownstown cemetery.

Mr. Tovey, who had been at the bedside of his mother for several days, returned home this morning and will go back in the morning in company with his wife to attend the funeral.
