Dr. J. C. Vermilya Dies At Home Here— Funeral Rites Tuesday

Ill only four days, death came early Sunday morning to 84-year-old Dr. Joseph C. Vermilya, retired physician, surgeon and druggist, at his home on North Main street.

Funeral rites were held at 4 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, in charge of the Rev. Wayland E. Siders, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church. Interment was in Fairview Cemetery, here.

A native of Brownstown, and one of the oldest residents in this area, Dr. Vermilya was born on April 26, 1872; a son of the late Wright V. and Josephine E. Miller Vermilya.

He was graduated in 1888 from Brownstown High School and also DePauw University, Greencastle, and the Cincinnati School of Medicine. For many years he followed the profession of a physician and surgeon and in later life was a pharmacist. In the latter profession he served both the Bloomington and Fairmount areas, owning a drug store at Fairmount from 1935 until his retirement in 1947.

Mrs. Vermilya, whom he married in Bloomington, has been deceased for many years.
