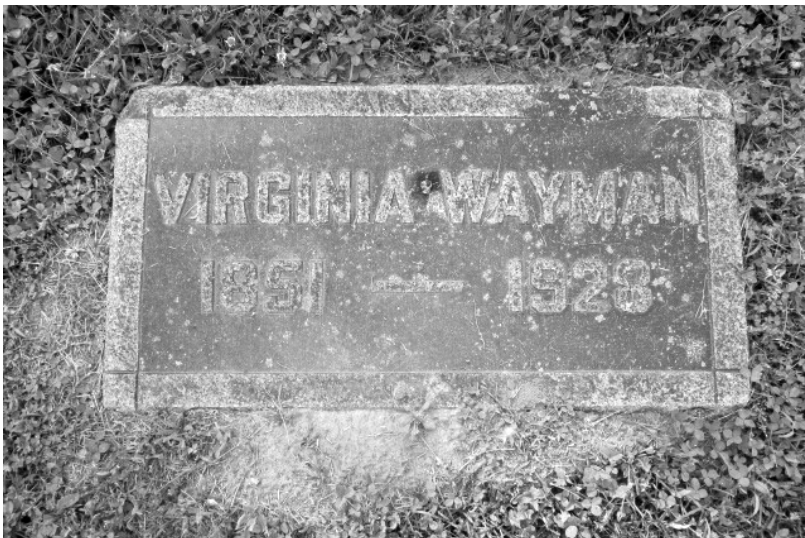

**Wayman**—Mrs. Virginia Robertson Wayman, wife of James W. Wayman, passed away at her home in Brownstown Tuesday evening, July 17, 1923, at 5:15 o'clock, aged 76 years, 8 months and 26 days. She had been in failing health for about five years.

Mrs. Wayman was a life long resident of Jackson county. She was born in Hamilton township, October 21, 1851, and was a daughter of William M. and Elizabeth Sewell Robertson. On February 20, 1872, she was married at Cincinnati to James W. Wayman. To their union were born seven children, of whom five preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held at the Christian church Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. E. E. Pedcord officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

In early life she united with the Christian church and remained a consistent member thereof until death. She was an active member of the church and all the auxiliaries, especially the Ladies Aid Society. She was of a quiet and loveable disposition and was especially devoted to her home and family.
