Welsh—Dr. Edgar Welsh, age 52, passed away at the Veterans Hospital at Marion, Indiana, Tuesday morning at 10:30 o'clock following a long illness.

Dr. Welsh was born in Brownstown on April 7, 1893, the son of John E. and Ella Robertson Welsh, both deceased. He was graduated from the Brownstown high school in 1914 and Indiana Dental college in 1917. He was a veteran of World War I and served as a Lieutenant in the Dental Corps.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Genevieve Welsh, of Chicago and a son, William Welsh, now serving in the Navy; a brother, M. W. Welsh, of Vincennes, and a sister, Mrs. Ray Vermilya, of Brownstown. He was a member of Brownstown F. & A. M. Lodge No. 13.

The remains will be brought to the Zabel Funeral Home, Brownstown, where services in charge of the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor of the Christian church, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock. Burial will be made in Fairview cemetery.
