A. M. WOODS DEAD.

Another of Brownstown's citizens has passed the river Jordan. After an illness covering a period of about three years, Alexander M. Woods, passed peacefully away, Saturday evening, April 14, 1894, at the home of his niece, Mrs Harry Cribb, with whom he has resided for several years. Deceased was 69 years of age. He was born in Washington county, July 17, 1825, and came to Brownstown many years ago. In fact he was one of the old timers, having spent almost fifty years here. He was married to Miss Mary E. Brown, sister of D. H. Brown, of Seymour, on the 17th day of July, 1833. He was a soldier in the Mexican war and also served in the rebellion. Being totally disabled during the last few years of his life, he drew sufficient pension to maintain himself. He was a member of the M. E. church having united with that organization about 15 years ago.

The funeral took place at 10 o'clock Monday from the residence, with Rev Fletcher conducting the religious exercises, followed by interment in the Brownstown cemetery. Deceased had no children.
