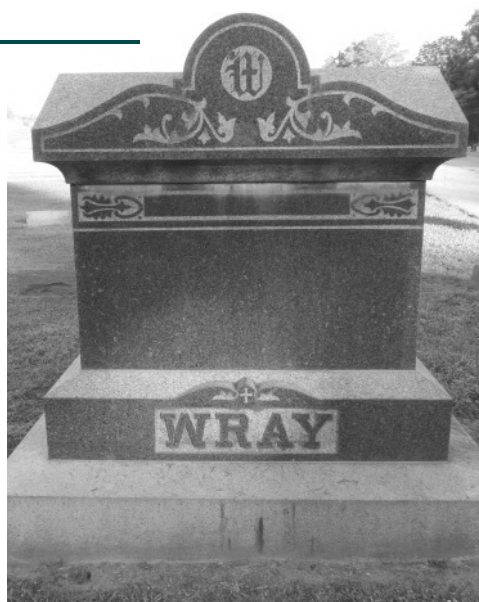

Mrs. Wilma E. Wray Dies at Age of 85

Mrs. Wilma Elizabeth Wray, 85, a life-long resident of Jackson county, died Friday afternoon at her home in Ewing, after a year's illness. She had been seriously ill for only two weeks, however.

Widely known throughout the western part of Jackson county, where she resided for many years before moving to Ewing, Mrs. Wray was also well known in Ewing, and she leaves a host of friends who mourn her passing. She was a member of Wray's Church, in western Jackson county.

Born July 4, 1867, in this county, Mrs. Wray was the daughter of the late James M. and Elizabeth Poole Henderson. She was married March 1, 1890, in this county, to James Wray, who survives.

Survivors in addition to the husband include three sons, James Price Wray and Ansel D. Wray, both of Detroit, Mich., and Ivan Wray, of Indianapolis.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock, DST, Monday afternoon from the Brownstown Christian Church, with the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor, in charge.
