

Second Branaman Triplet Dies

Only one child now survives from the first set of triplets ever born at Schneck Memorial Hospital here.

Dwayne Albert Branaman, four months old, died Friday night at Riley Children's Hospital in Indianapolis, where he had been listed in critical condition since Dec. 17 last year.
