WEEKLY DEATH RECORD
Browning—Frank Browning, age 72, a former Brownstown resident whose critical illness was mentioned last week, passed away at the Mt. Carmel hospital at Pittsburg, Kansas, Thursday, August 22. His death was due to a complication of diseases, with which he had been afflicted about two years.

Frank Emerson Browning was born at Pleasant Grove, Jackson county, to Jesse and Caroline Richards Browning, March 9, 1857. He was married to Emma C. Cummins in Hamilton township October 16, 1878. To their union were born four children of whom three, Earl, of Brownstown, Ray, of Evansville, and Mrs. Loui Cartwright, of West Newton, Penn., survive him also three grandchildren and one great-grandchild. His wife preceded him in death January 8, 1923. On April 30, 1924 he was married to Mary Mayfield, who survives him. He also leaves two sisters, Mrs. Rachael Heller, of Free-town, and Mrs. Mrs. Alvira Kerner, of Hobson Hill.

In early life he united with the Methodist church and after moving to Missouri he was ordained a minister in the United Brethren church.

The body was brought here Saturday and taken to the home of his son, Earl. Funeral services were held at the Methodist church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Leo S. Lovell officiating. Burial in Fair-view cemetery.
