England—James Lewis England, age 78 years, 8 months and 10 days, died at his home in Brownstown Friday afternoon at 5:30 o'clock. Death followed a two years' illness.

Funeral services were conducted at the Church of the Nazarene Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Sutherland. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mr. England was born in Washington county, Indiana, September 23, 1859 and was the last surviving member of a family of seven children born to Andrew and Rhoda Weeks England. He was married in Brownstown May 4, 1886 to Fannie Banks who survives. They had no children, but raised Grover England, who died October 19, 1935. Mr. England was a laborer by occupation and was an industrious worker as long as his health permitted. He was a member of the Red Men lodge and had many friends. He was baptized in the Christian church in September, 1887. His widow is his only survivor.
