Death of Mrs. Ford.

Mrs. ELIZABETH R. FORD, relict of Dr. John L. Ford, deceased, died suddenly on Wednesday afternoon, August 30th, in this place. She had been unwell for a few days, but was able to be about. About four o'clock of the day mentioned, her daughter gave her a dose of medicine prescribed by her physician. As she swallowed the dose, she remarked that that medicine made her feel deathly sick, and immediately fell back dead. Her death is attributed to heart disease.

Mrs. Ford was born in Clark county, December 23, 1823. She joined the Christian church when quite young. March 15, 1840, she was married to Dr. John L. Ford, and with him came to Brownstown in 1843. During the same year, she connected herself with the M. E. Church, and remained a devout and faithful member until her death. Her husband died in 1861, since which time she remained a widow. She was a truly good woman-one whose highest ambition was to serve God faithfully and do her whole duty not only to Him, but also to her children and fellow-creatures generally. She died at the age of 52 years, 8 months and 7 days, having lived to see her children married and settled down in life. Her remains were taken to the M. E. Church on Thursday, where appropriate services were conducted by Rev. W. W. Reynolds, after which they were deposited in the new cemetery.
