John W. Heller, 69, Buried Saturday

John W. Heller, aged 69 years, died at his home, about a mile south of Brownstown Thursday night at 6 o'clock after an illness of four months.

Mr. Heller was a well known Jackson county farmer and was one of the four original organizers of the Jackson Brick and Holloware Company in Brownstown of which he was one of the officers until recently. He was a member of the Brownstown Masonic Lodge.

The son of the late John W. and Phoebe Doerr Heller, he was born August 25, 1878. He spent his entire life in Jackson county and died in the room where he was born. He was married in Seymour Jan. 23, 1907, to Miss Margaret Shields of Brownstown, who survives.

Surviving besides the widow is one son, James P. Heller; two brothers, Thornton and James B. Heller, and a sister, Miss Bertha Heller, all of Brownstown.

Funeral services in charge of the Rev. Russell Hall, pastor of the Methodist church, were conducted at the family home Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
