Lee Long, B'town Native, Succumbs— Burial Rites Here

Burial rites were held Saturday morning at Fairview Cemetery here, for Lee Long, of Indianapolis, a native of Brownstown, who died Thursday at a nursing home in Indianapolis.

Washington Lodge No. 13, F. & A. M., was in charge of the burial service and 32nd Degree Masonic rites were held earlier Thursday morning from the Wilson Funeral Home, Indianapolis.

Mr. Long was one of seven children of the late Captain Byford E. Long and Mollie Gosley Long. He attended school here, leaving Brownstown when a young man. For thirty years he had owned and operated the Fixit Shop, an electrical repair business, at 36½ West Washington street, Indianapolis.

Mr. Long was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Scottish Rite and Shrine.

Surviving are a brother, Richard Long, of Atlanta, Georgia, who with a nephew, Byford Wagstaff, also of Atlanta, accompanied the body to Brownstown.
