Former Citizen Dies In Detroit

Remains of Paris G. Long, Aged
About 57, Brought to Browns-
town For Burial Today.

The remains of Paris G. Long, aged about 57, were brought to Brownstown this morning and taken to the Wallace funeral home, where services conducted by Rev. Roy Brumbaugh, this afternoon followed by interment in Fairview cemetery. His death resulted from diabetes, with which he (Continued to Page Eight)

had been afflicted for about two years.

Deceased was born and reared in Brownstown and was a son of the late Capt. B. E. Long. He lived at Indianapolis for a number of years, later moving to Detroit. For a number of years he was employed in the U. S. secret service on the narcotic squad, but in later years had been employed in the city sanitary department at Detroit.

He is survived by one son, Graham, and one daughter, Mary, of Detroit, and three brothers and two sisters, viz: B. E. Long, Jr., of Washington, D.
