John Wesley Simpson Mercer was J. Wesley S. Mercer born near Newcomerstown, Ohio, December 31st 1863. Died at Brown town, Indiana, September 30, 1894. Merer in the publication of the Medina (O.) Democrat in the fall of 1885. A year later he severed his connection w th that institution and pursued a varing e course of action until in Nov.,

., he came to Brownstown, Indiana, assumed editorial control of the enstown Banner. This position illed with credit for almost two . From this post he went to Gar-Iowa, and assumed full control of

Hancock Democrat where he wie ded a vigorous pen and won many friends. He sold his interests there in the fall of 1890 and in April following removed to Indianapolis where he contiqued in the printing business until impaired health compelled him to relinquish labor. In his weakened condition he came again to Brownstown, in July 1893, in the hope that quietude and rest would be beneficial to his health.
