The remains of Mrs. Lydia Clayton, wife of Charles Clayton, of Jeffersonville, were shipped through here this morning en route to her former home at Brownstown for burial. Mrs. Clayton died Tuesday at Jeffersonville, following a stroke of paralysis. A year ago she underwent an operation for cancer and her weakened condition brought on the paralysis.
