Former County Official Dies At Hospital

**Funeral Rites Held Sunday
For Frank L. Schornick,
88, Former Clerk of Jack-
son Circuit Court.**

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon from the Johnson Funeral Home, Vallonia, for Frank L. Schornick, former clerk of the Jackson Circuit Court, and a widely known Jackson County resident, who died late Thursday night at the Jackson County Hospital.

He had been ill only a week.

Mr. Schornick, who was 88 years of age, was born in Brownstown, July 14, 1882, a son of the late John and Mary Ann Cornett Schornick. All of his long life, except six years spent in Texas, was lived in Jackson County.

On November 18, 1937, in Greenbelt, Texas, he married Nellie Tidell, who survives.

In addition to serving as clerk of the Jackson County Circuit Court, Mr. Schornick also was a retired salesman and at one time a receiver for a former Crothersville bank.

He was a member of the Vallonia Christian Church, whose pastor, Johnny Johnson, conducted the funeral rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.

Surviving with the widow are three children, Mrs. Lois Hotchkiss, of Brownstown, Mrs. Thelma Fulkrod, of Florida, and Maurice L. Schornick, of Greenwood.

He also leaves three stepchildren, Mrs. Lena Grider, of Tulsa, Arizona, Mrs. Maude Dowling, of Columbus, and Lawrence Sullivan of Brownstown.

Two brothers and two sisters are deceased.
